

Electrical Safety Awareness


Course Overview

This course provides essential training for workers who may be exposed to electrical hazards in the workplace. Electricity is a serious workplace hazard that can cause electric shock, electrocution, burns, fires, and explosions. This awareness-level course is designed to help employees recognize electrical risks, understand basic safety principles, and take appropriate precautions to prevent injuries.

The course emphasizes hazard identification, safe work practices, and compliance with relevant OSHA standards, making it ideal for non-electrical workers (unqualified persons) who work near electrical equipment or systems operating at 50 volts or higher.

Key Learning Objectives

- Recognize common electrical hazards in the workplace
- Understand the effects of electric shock on the human body
- Identify safe work practices around electrical equipment
- Awareness of LOTO as it applies to affected workers
- Know when and how to use personal protective equipment (PPE)
- Respond appropriately to electrical emergencies
- Comply with relevant regulations and safe work practices

Target Audience: This course is ideal for general industry and construction workers who work around electrical equipment, but ultimately, any employee in environments where electricity is present and hazards could exist


Compliance: Aligns with OSHA 1910 Subpart S and NFPA 70E requirements
