

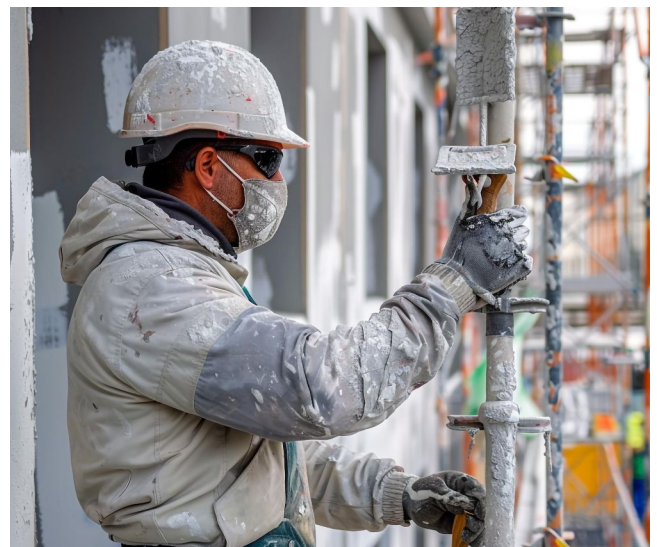

OUR COURSE OVERVIEW

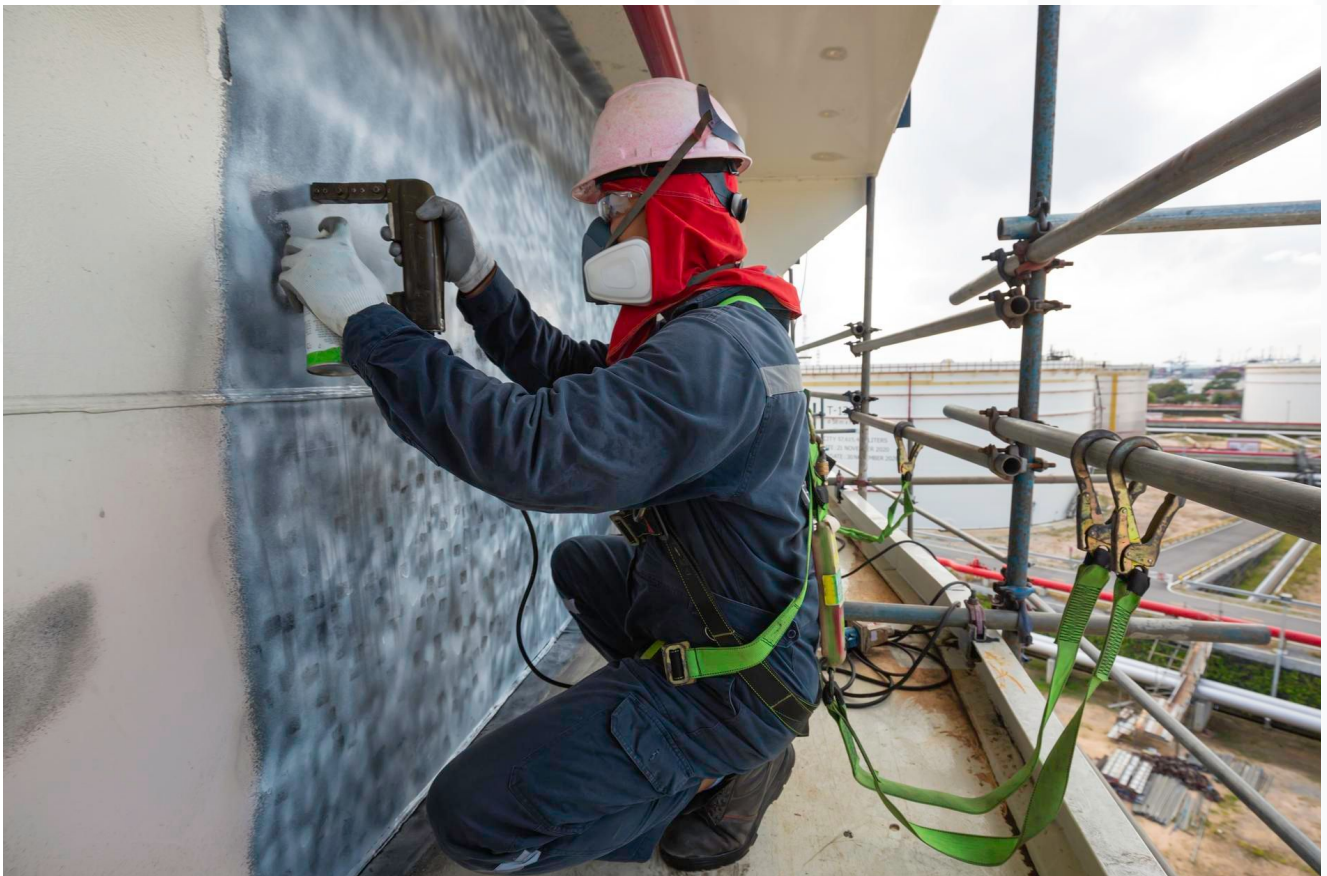
This comprehensive course provides essential training for workers who may be exposed to airborne contaminants in construction, industrial, maintenance, and other workplace environments.
